STATEMENT OF STUDENT EXPECTATIONS



Enrolment at Trafalgar High School carries with it the following expectations:

- Attending all scheduled classes (including Multi-Purpose Period and Private Study classes), form assembly, year level assemblies, school assemblies and sports days.
- Punctual attendance at all classes/activities with the required equipment to begin learning.
- Completing set work both in class and at home by the due date and to the best of your ability.
- Respecting the right of staff to teach and students to learn without unnecessary disruption.
- Following all staff directions and instructions both in and out of the classroom.
- Assist in creating an environment free from interference, distraction and any form of harassment.
- Complying with all school policies, such as the Mobile Phone Policy, School Uniform Policy and the Acceptable use of ICT policy.
- Ensuring that appropriate and respectful language is used at all times, i.e. no swearing.
- Explaining any absences from school with: a note, phone call, Compass entry or a medical certificate by parents/guardians.
- Respecting school property and the property of other students.
- Staying within the school grounds during the school day unless sign out process completed.
- Carrying the Student Diary when moving around the school.
- Behaving at all times in ways that help to promote a positive image of the school.

In the event where a student has behaved in a manner that does not meet student expectations, a process as set by the Trafalgar High School Student Management Policy will be followed. All incidents shall be dealt in an appropriate, consistent and systematic way.

Trafalgar High School is a complex teaching and learning environment. It is important that all members of the school community have confidence in our value system and student expectations.


